Profile of His Excellency, Mr. Udom Emmanuel, Governor of Akwa Ibom State.

r. Udom Emmanuel, the Governor of Akwa Ibom State since May 29, 2015, is a technocrat and one of the faces who came into the public square with verifiable body of work and achievements. Governor Emmanuel also served as a Non-Executive Director, Africa Finance Corporation (AFC), Director, Nigerian Inter-Banks Settlement System (NIBBS). He, was the first indigene of Akwa Ibom and Cross River States respectively to be appointed into the board of AFC.

In July 2013, the immediate past Governor of Akwa Ibom State Senator Godswill Akpabio, impressed by his professional achievements as a corporate titan, appointed him the Secretary to the Akwa Ibom State Government, a position he acquitted himself creditably, leading to the good people of the state believing that the destiny of continuous greatness and forward movement of the state resides in his capable hands.

On April 11, 2015, having won the primaries to emerge the PDP Gubernatorial Candidate, in December 2014, he was massively elected the Governor of Akwa Ibom State, from where he has brought his 'can-do' spirit to the state, challenging the people to 'Dakkada' (stand -up) and assume the greatness, drive and new approach to doing things and this spiritual and moral rebirth has been happily internalized by the people of the state.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT/ REVENUE GENERATION





In the area of social welfare the administration has given care to and catered for:

- over 800 Orphans and less privileged children in five Government Homes. viz:
 - Special Children's Home, Uyo
 - Divine Children's Home, Uyo
 - Correctional Centre, Uyo
 - Shelter Afrique Transit Camp, Uyo
 - Government Children's Home, Ikot Ekpene
- Provision of N200,000.00 grant each to about 500 women organizations across the 31 LGAs
- Provision of N50,000.00 grant each and wrappers to about 600 widows across the 31 LGAs to boost their businesses and alleviate poverty
- Provision of N50,000.00 each and wrappers as well as food items to about 350 mothers with multiple births across the 31 LGAs in collaboration with the Family Enhancement and Youth Re-orientation Programme
- Implementation of the Child Rights Law. amily Empowerment and Youth Reorientation Path-Initiative (FEYReP), the pet-project of the wife of the Governor, Mrs. Martha Emmanuel, is a vehicle of social intervention with the aim to reach out to the people of the state especially the vulnerable ones in order to ameliorate their living conditions. FEYReP through her multi-faceted programmes, is working assiduously to support government's sustainable development

agenda.

Family Empowerment and Youth Reorientation Path-Initiative (FEYReP) is about service: social service that was long done in a smaller scale before the opportunity to do more was presented.

In the three years of her existence, FEYReP's goal to increase the levels of citizen participation and empowerment, has been on the front burner of all activities. FEYReP has continued to go the extra-mile to ensure the best living conditions, economic, social and community empowerment for the citizenry of the state.

FEYReP has built and commissioned six agro processing factories across the three senatorial districts in the following order:

 The riverine communities of Ibaka in Mbo and Upenekang in Ibeno Local Government Areas are host communities to FEYReP's fish and seafood processing factories, built with modern facilities to accommodate 4 tonnage of daily fish processing.

- The Oil-palm processing factories in Oruk-Anam and Etim Ekpo Local Government Areas are envisioned to
- ease processing, accelerate productivity and increase daily income for rural women.
- FEYReP's cassava processing factories in Ibiono and Ini Local Government Areas were built to take 11 tons of daily cassava processing, increase the processing of garri (a processed variant
- of cassava) with the primary goal of crashing its market price, whilst also improving the income of rural farmers.
- FEYReP supports women and girls via educating the girl-child with both entrepreneurial and life skills. The very foundation of our society in the 21st
